This week Mari McNeil, Head of Christian Aid Wales writes us a letter...

Dear teachers and parents,

As all our thoughts are on the Covid-19 situation and as schools across Wales close, we would like to share with you an activity and resource for use at home over the coming weeks.

We live in an increasingly interconnected world. Our local community is global. Coronavirus has shown us that our futures are bound more tightly together than ever before.

The climate crisis remains one of the most critical issues of our time and we want to share children's reflections on creation with the leaders of our world. Could your pupils or children use their creative skills to develop a 'think piece' on the beauty of the natural world and the importance of climate justice?

Over these coming weeks, why not use the materials suggested in the Letters for Creation pack to introduce your pupils or children to the theme, and invite them to create a piece of writing, music, drama, or artwork on climate justice. The Letters for Creation teaching pack touches on different aspects of learning: science, geography, religious education, language, art.
