

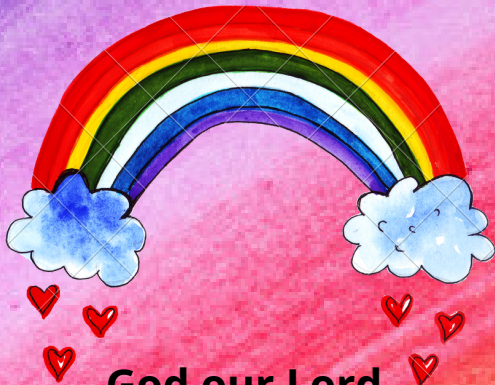

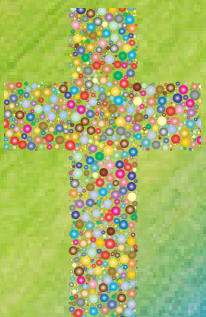


God our Lord,

or

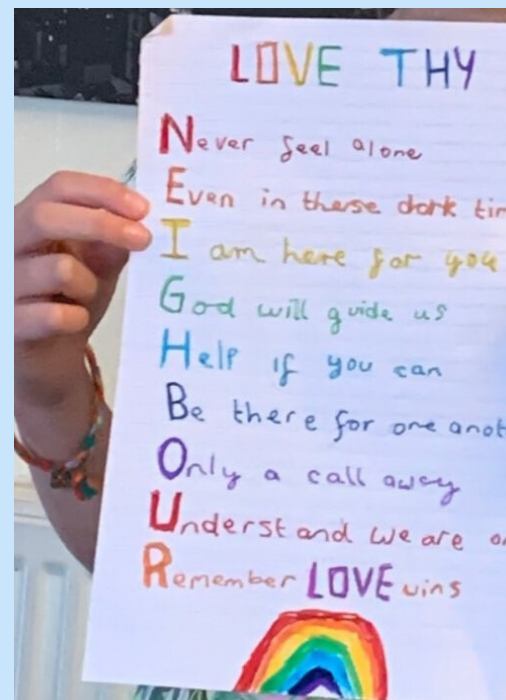
You might wish to gather memories and personal stories about life during lock-down.

Collect pictures and words to describe these times in your life.

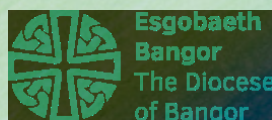
Acrostic Poem by a pupil of Ysgol Esgob Morgan
